Through engagement and counseling on the streets, where men and women are living without shelter, we meet people where they are and help them get on the path to permanent housing.



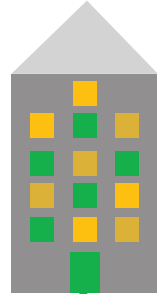
